Thus, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers use hydraulic pressure in order to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. The crawler crane is unique in that it has big tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are really similar to backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks enable the crane to successfully move around a construction locations.
